



#### 2 JOIN A COURSE


Click the **Join a Course or Exam** button. Before you do this, make sure you have the six-character join code from your teacher. You'll need it to join a class section.


## 4 VERIFY COURSE INFORMATION

Make sure the information that comes up is for the course you're taking. If it is, click **Yes**.



## 5 FILL OUT REGISTRATION INFORMATION

The first time you enroll in an AP course in My AP, you'll provide registration information. It's important to be accurate. You only have to do this once. Check your information that's already shown and provide the remaining information. If your name, middle initial, or date of birth needs correcting, contact AP Services for Students after completing your registration. If you make changes to any other information in your AP Profile, you'll also need to sign into your College Board account to make the same changes.



#### 6 CONGRATULATIONS!

You're enrolled in your AP course. If you're taking multiple AP courses, repeat steps 2-4 for each course you're taking this year, using the unique join code for each course.

All College Board programs are connected through one account, so if you created one for AP, PSAT/NMSQT, SAT, or BigFuture® Opportunity Scholarships, you're all set.

Students in any of the categories below are eligible to take AP Exams at the secondary school where they're enrolled or at other AP-authorized schools or test centers:

- 1)Students actively enrolled in secondary school.
- 2)Secondary school-level students who are homeschooled, participate in independent study, or attend a virtual school.
- 3) Actively enrolled students who may be prepared to take an AP Exam prior to the ninth grade.
- 4)Recent secondary school graduates who need a specific AP Exam for university admission
